## SECOND SEASON IN APOGEE BEGINS AGAINST TEXAS SOUTHERN

→ North Texas opens the second season in Apogee Stadium against the Texas Southern Tigers. The Mean Green fell on the road to LSU 41-14 while the Tigers won on a last second field goal over Prairie View A&M 44-41 in their season opener.

→ Against LSU in the opening week, North Texas had nine players on defense that either set or tied new career highs with tackles.

→ Redshirt freshman Zac Whitfield had his first career interception against LSU. It was the first interception by a Mean Green freshman since Jeremy Phillips in 2009. Digging deeper finds that Whitfield's interception was the first by a freshman cornerback since Antoine Bush in 2006. Additionally there were 98 players in the nation with interceptions after the first week and Whitfield was one of only seven freshman nationally to have a pick.

→ North Texas is 55-24-2 all-time in home opening games. However the Mean Green has lost seven of the last eight home openers with the only win during that time coming in a victory over SMU in 2006.

→ The Mean Green is looking to avoid an 0-2 start to the season for the third straight year. Since returning to FBS in 1995, North Texas has started the year out with a 1-1 record only six times, with the most recent being 2009.

→ Derek Thompson's 80-yard touchdown strike to Brelan Chancellor against LSU was tied for the seventh longest passing play in school history. Thompson now has two of the seven longest passes in school history, as he sits sixth all-time with an 83-yard pass last season. Only Steven Ramsey, who owns three of the top seven plays, has more than Thompson.

→ Thompson had two touchdown passes for North Texas against LSU in the season opening game. It is the first time since returning to FBS football in 1995 that a quarterback has thrown for two TD's in the season opening game and a receiver has had two TD receptions. The last time a Mean Green quarterback threw for two touchdowns in the first game of the season was 1994 when Mitch Maher threw for three. Meanwhile Chancellor was the first North Texas wide receiver with two touchdown receptions in the opening game since that same season opening game against Abilene Christian. That night David Brown caught two TD passes from Maher.

## THE MATCHUP BY THE NUMBERS

**0** - Sacks allowed by the North Texas offensive line against LSU. The Mean Green is one of 28 teams in the nation that did not allow a sack after the first week.

**1** - North Texas has only faced one team ever from the SWAC. The Mean Green played Alcorn State in 1990, a 20-7 win at Fouts Field.

**27.5** - The Mean Green has averaged 27.5 points in the last four home openers. North Texas has scored 20 or more points in six straight home openers and topped 30 in the last two home openers.

**39.4** - By contrast North Texas has allowed 30 points or more in four straight home openers. Opponents have averaged 39.4 points in the home opener for the Mean Green. NT hasn't held an opponent to less than 10 points in a home opener since 2006 against SMU.

**66.7** - The Mean Green winning percentage in Apogee Stadium in 2011. It was the first winning home season for North Texas since 2004.

**100** - The North Texas defense has not had a shutout since blanking the Troy Trojans 21-0 in 2003. It has been 100 games since the last shutout.

**240** - With 184 all-purpose yards against LSU, Brelan Chancellor sits just 240 all-purpose yards away from being in the top-10 all-time at North Texas. He would become the fifth player since 2001 with more than 3,000 all-purpose yards in their career with the Mean Green.

**113,186** - Total attendance last season, a new school record for North Texas. The Mean Green the last two home openers has averaged 25,909.

## THE LAST TIME OUT.....

BATON ROUGE, Louisiana - North Texas came to Death Valley looking for an upset of the top-ranked team in the nation, but LSU was having none of it Saturday night. LSU was looking for the kind of massacre oddsmakers expected, but North Texas was having none of that. What each had to settle for was a 41-14 LSU victory in both team's season opener. LSU ended any Mean Green hopes of a win by exploding for a 24-0 lead in the first half, but North Texas shook off the effects of the haymaker to score twice while bringing the Tiger onslaught under control. Two Derek Thompson to Brelan Chancellor touchdown passes gave North Texas 14 points - more than the Mean Green had scored in four previous meetings with LSU. LSU's 41 points matched the fewest the Tigers have scored against North Texas, and the 27-point margin was the closest in the series. North Texas did not allow a sack to the much-touted LSU pass rush, and Chancellor had 114 yards receiving.

#### **Practice Coverage**

Media has limited access to North Texas football practice. The media may view the first five periods of practices on Tuesday and Wednesday. The remaining practice is closed to all media and fans. .

#### **Sun Belt Teleconference**

The Sun Belt Conference will conduct a weekly teleconference with each of the 10 head coaches each Monday throughout the season. Coach McCarney will be on the call from 11:08-11:14 a.m. each week.

#### **Credentials For Media**

Those wishing to cover North Texas must contact Eric Capper or Steven Bartolotta for credentials for home and away games.

#### **Tuesday Press Conference**

All player and coach interviews will be conducted at a press conference on Tuesday afternoon at the Athletic Center at 11:30 a.m. **Requests for players should be made in advance through the sports information office by Monday at 12 p.m.** Players requested and unable to attend the press conference on Tuesday will be made available after practice on Tuesday. Special exemptions may be granted to those media wishing to interview a specific student-athlete before practice at the discretion of the media relations office.

#### **Post-Practice Interviews**

Interviews following practice will be conducted only for requested players not available at Tuesday's press conference. All out of town media with request for Coach McCarney, assistant coaches or players must contact Eric Capper or Steven Bartolotta.

#### **Post-Game Interviews**

The North Texas locker room is closed to all members of the media. Head coach Dan McCarney and requested players will be available for interviews following a brief cooling off period. Postgame interviews at Apogee Stadium will be held in the team meeting room in the athletic center.

#### **The 97th Has Begun**

With the season-opener at LSU last week, North Texas has begun its 97th season of football. Since the inaugural season in 1913, North Texas has accumulated a record of 475-459-33, amassed 25 conference championships and played in seven bowl games.

#### **Home Openers**

North Texas is 55-24-2 all-time in home-opening games, but has lost its last five. The last home-opening win for the Mean Green was a 24-6 win over SMU in 2006. Head Coach Dan McCarney lost his first home-opener at North Texas with a 48-23 loss to Houston last season – which was also the first game ever played in Apogee Stadium.

#### **Mean Green vs. FCS**

Since returning to FBS (Div. I-A) football in 1995, North Texas is 5-0 against teams from the FCS (Div. I-AA). The Mean Green has only played one FCS team in the last 11 seasons, a 23-0 win over Nicholls State in 2002. North Texas also defeated Samford 41-6 in 2000, Indiana State 41-6 in 1997, Illinois State 20-14 in 1996 and Idaho State 41-38 in 1995.

#### **FCS Upsets**

While North Texas has not lost to an FCS team since returning to FBS in 1995, Mean Green head coach Dan McCarney has plenty of ammunition to warn his team about the danger of facing a team like Texas Southern. In the first week of the season, four FCS teams upset FBS teams to help McCarney drive home his point. McNeese State defeated fellow Sun Belt member Middle Tennessee 27-21, Eastern Washington defeated Idaho 20-3, Tennessee-Martin beat Memphis 20-17 and Youngstown State defeated Pitt 31-17. McCarney is 8-0 as a head coach vs. FCS (I-AA) teams all-time.

#### **Facing Top Ranked Opponents**

North Texas 41-14 loss to LSU last week was the latest in a long list of highly-ranked opponents that the Mean Green has faced over the past 13 years. Since 2000 North Texas has faced 12 teams ranked in the top 10, including eight that were ranked in the top five. The 2010 season was the only time in the last 13 years that the Mean Green didn't face a top-10 team. LSU was the fourth No. 1-ranked team that North Texas has battled in school history with the other three coming against Arkansas in 1965 and Oklahoma in both 1987 and 2003.

#### **Some Success**

While head coach Dan McCarney does not celebrate moral victories, North Texas 41-14 loss at No. 1 LSU did produce some silver lining successes. The 14 points was the most North Texas has ever scored against LSU in five meetings and the first time it scored a touchdown against the Tigers since the first meeting in 1995. The Mean Green had only scored a combined total of six points in the previous three meetings with LSU. It was also the most points that North Texas has scored vs. an opponent ranked in the top five since it scored 14 at No. 1 Oklahoma in 1987.

#### **Developing Defense**

Five of the 11 starters for the North Texas defense last week against LSU were making their first career start, including all four members of the defensive secondary. Cornerbacks Hilbert Jackson and Zac Whitfield along with safeties Marcus Trice and Lairamie Lee were all in the starting lineup for the first time with the Mean Green. Junior defensive tackle Richard Abbe also made his initial North Texas start against the Tigers.

#### **Returning Rushing Yards**

With the departure of the school's all-time leading rusher Lance Dunbar, North Texas will have to rely on a bevy of inexperienced backs to fill his shoes. Coming into the season, the Mean Green returned only 338 rushing yards from last year – and only 106 of that is from the running back position (Byrd with 83 and Brown with 23). Only five schools in FBS football returned fewer total rushing yards than North Texas going into 2012.

### O-Line Shines

The North Texas offensive line turned in more than an admirable performance against No. 1 LSU last week. The unit didn't allow a single sack against a team that averaged nearly three per game last year and didn't have any penalties in the game.

### The Youth Movement Begins

With only 11 scholarship seniors on the roster, North Texas is tied for the eighth-youngest team in the nation. In the two-deep, the Mean Green has 12 true or redshirt freshmen. Of the 46 players on the offensive and defensive two-deep, 22 are either freshman, redshirt freshman or sophomores.

### Babyish Backfield

No position group on the North Texas team reflects that more youth than the defensive secondary. The Mean Green is one of only four teams in the nation without a senior starter in the secondary to begin the year. The other three teams with no seniors in the backfield are LSU, Florida State and Virginia.

### Atterberry Named to Ray Guy Watch List

North Texas senior punter Will Atterberry is on the Ray Guy Award preseason watch list heading into the 2012 season. Atterberry is one of 25 players on the list. This is his second straight year to be a candidate for the award, which goes to the nation's best punter. In his first game at LSU last week, Atterberry averaged 40.9 yards on eight punts and downed two inside the Tiger 20-yard line. He led the Sun Belt Conference in punting last season at 43.5 yards a kick and was named to the All-Sun Belt First Team. Atterberry had 16 punts of over 50 yards in 2011 and 26 punts that were inside the 20-yard line, which ranked eighth nationally. His average of 43.5 yards a kick was 24th in the nation last season and he is the nation's 16th-leading punter returning for the 2012 season. Atterberry is the only punter from the Sun Belt Conference to make this list.

### Two Named to Preseason All-Conference

North Texas senior punter Will Atterberry and sophomore offensive lineman Cyril Lemon were named to the 2012 Preseason All-Sun Belt team. Atterberry was the leading punter in the Sun Belt Conference last season, while Lemon was the only true freshman offensive lineman in the nation to start all 12 games and receive all-conference honors. Lemon is one of only three sophomores to be part of the preseason all-conference team and is the only underclassman on the all-conference team that is an offensive lineman.

### Hayden Fry Tree

Former North Texas and Iowa head coach Hayden Fry has one of the most established coaching trees in the history of college football, including current Mean Green head coach Dan McCarney. Fry has had 26 of his former assistants go on to become either college or professional head coaches, including 10 that have been head coaches at the FBS (Div. I-A) level and six that are still active FBS coaches. And these are not just any coaches. The 10 FBS coaches who are former Fry assistants have combined to lead their teams to more than 60 bowl games as head coaches.

### First Year Success

Head Coach Dan McCarney started to turn the North Texas program around in short time. In his first year, McCarney led North Texas to its most wins in a single season since 2004 and a tie for the fourth-most wins in a single season since returning to FBS football in 1995. The Mean Green also notched the most league wins since 2004 and McCarney had the most conference wins by a first-year head coach at the FBS level at North Texas since 1973. McCarney collected the most wins by a first-year head coach since 1994 and the sixth-most by a first-year head coach ever at North Texas. The five wins also matched the most wins by a first-year head coach at the FBS level since 1979.

### Television Networks Go Green

The Mean Green will have its first seven games and 10 games overall televised this season. The season opener at LSU was on ESPNU. The home opener against Texas Southern will be broadcast on TXA 21 in Dallas/Fort Worth. The matchup against Kansas State is going to be televised on Fox Sports Net. The first two Sun Belt Conference games -- at home against Troy and a road matchup with Florida Atlantic -- will be televised on ESPN3. On Oct. 6, Comcast Sports South will broadcast North Texas and Houston before ESPN2 spotlights North Texas at home against Louisiana-Lafayette for a Tuesday night feature. The final home game of the year against South Alabama will be on TXA 21 once again. The Mean Green's final televised regular season game will be on the road at Western Kentucky on Nov. 24, broadcast on the Sun Belt Network.

### Momentum Moving Forward

For only the fifth time since 1986, North Texas ended the season having won three of its final five games. The last five games were the best since 2004 for the Mean Green. The 59-7 win over Middle Tennessee to end the 2011 season was the biggest margin of victory for the Mean Green ever in Sun Belt conference play while racking up 464 rushing yards, which tied a school record. The 59 points were the most points in a season-finale game for North Texas since scoring 63 against Drake in 1976.

### Graduate Work

Quarterback Derek Thompson and defensive lineman Ryan Boutwell each completed their undergraduate degrees by graduating in August. Both Thompson and Boutwell earned their degrees in Kinesiology in three years and have two years of eligibility remaining. Boutwell begins graduate school this fall in Kinesiology while Thompson begins graduate school in recreation and Leisure Studies.

### See You in C-USA

On May 4, 2012 the University of North Texas was extended and accepted an invitation for Conference USA membership effective July 1, 2013. North Texas is one of six schools that will be joining Conference USA. North Texas, the University of Texas-San Antonio, Louisiana Tech University, Florida International University and the University of North Carolina-Charlotte accepted invitations on May 4. On May 17, Old Dominion University announced it was also accepting C-USA's invitation. Each new member will join the league in all sports for 2013; Charlotte will begin conference participation in football in 2015. The metro area population of these schools is nearly 18 million. Existing members are East Carolina University, Marshall University, Rice University, University of Southern Mississippi, Tulane University, The University of Tulsa, University of Alabama at Birmingham (UAB) and University of Texas El Paso (UTEP). Divisions will be set in the near future. The 14 members will also allow the Conference to continue to host its annual Football Championship game pitting champions from the East and West Divisions.



### Captains and Leadership Committee Named

Head Coach Dan McCarney has announced the team's 2012 captains and Leadership Committee, which will serve as the primary representatives for on-field and off-field activities. Captains elected by a team vote are senior offensive lineman Aaron Fortenberry, junior quarterback Derek Thompson, junior linebacker Zach Orr and junior defensive end Brandon McCoy. The Leadership Committee for this year will be Fortenberry and Orr as well as senior Nicolas Summerfield, junior Brandin Byrd, sophomores Andrew McNulty, Mason Y'Barbo and freshmen Zac Whitfield, Antoine Jimmerson, Kaydon Kirby and David Busby.

### **Final Season in the Sun**

North Texas football begins its 12th and final season as a member of the Sun Belt Conference before joining Conference USA in time for the 2013 season. The Mean Green entered the Sun Belt Conference in 2001, finished the campaign as Sun Belt Co-Champions and earned a berth in the New Orleans Bowl. North Texas went on to win four straight Sun Belt Conference titles from 2001-04 and play in four New Orleans Bowls during the same time. North Texas had a 26-game conference winning streak that stretched from 2001-05, a record that still stands. Since 2001, the Mean Green has had 95 players named to the all-conference team, and of those 49 were first-team all-conference selections. Jamario Thomas was the 2004 SBC Player of the Year and Brandon Kennedy a two-time Player of the Year in 2003 and 2002. Thomas was the Offensive Player of the Year in 2004, while Patrick Cobbs won the award in 2003. Chris Hurd was the Defensive Player of the Year in 2003, Kennedy in 2002, and Brad Kassell in 2001. Giovanni Vizza won the Freshman of the Year in 2007, Thomas in 2004, and Ja'Mel Branch in 2001. Aaron Weathers was the Newcomer of the Year in 2005, Dylan Lineberry in 2004, and Kevin Galbreath in 2001. Coach Darrell Dickey was a four-time Coach of the Year winner from 2001-04.

### **Payton Addresses Team**

New Orleans Saints Super Bowl champion head coach Sean Payton spoke to the North Texas football team as part of Dan McCarney's Champions Day tradition which symbolizes the conclusion of two-a-days. Payton emphasized the importance in believing in the power of the team and how that can change the culture within the community. Payton drew parallels between the turnaround in the Saints and what McCarney is doing at North Texas. Payton took over a team in 2006 that was 3-13 prior to his arrival and in four years turned it into a Super Bowl championship team. McCarney began the Champions Day tradition in his first year at North Texas when former Dallas Cowboys standout wide receiver Drew Pearson addressed the team.

### **Quality Losses**

All seven of North Texas' losses in 2011 were to teams that were bowl eligible with at least seven wins. The combined record of the three non-conference opponents to beat North Texas was 33-7, including BCS National Champion Alabama (12-1) and 14th-ranked Houston (13-1). North Texas also dropped games to Tulsa (8-5), Arkansas State (10-3), Louisiana-Lafayette (9-4), FIU (8-5) and Western Kentucky (7-5).

### **New Faces, Old Friends**

Head coach Dan McCarney added two new coaches to his staff this past season, Jon Skladany as his defensive coordinator and Noah Joseph as the safeties coach. Skladany and McCarney have a long history together having worked together at Iowa State. Skladany was the defensive coordinator for the Cyclones from 1997-06 with McCarney. Most recently he was the defensive coordinator at UCF, where last season the Golden Knights finished ninth in the nation in total defense. Joseph arrives at North Texas from Montana State where he was the Co-Defensive Coordinator and secondary coach since 2007.

### **Mean Green Bloodlines**

North Texas has its share of players on the roster that have great genes of their own but some have even better bloodlines. Linebacker Zachary Orr is the son of former NFL tight end Terry Orr, who was a member of the Washington Redskins Super Bowl teams in 1987 and 1991. Senior wide receiver Chris Bynes is the brother of Josh Bynes who was the leading tackler for the 2011 national champion Auburn Tigers and current member of the Baltimore Ravens. Junior linebacker Jeremy Phillips is the younger brother of Jason Phillips, the 2008 Mountain West Defensive Player of the Year for TCU and current Carolina Panthers linebacker. Tight end Andrew Power's brother, James, is the deep snapper for Thundering Herd of Marshall.

### **Well Represented in the NFL**

North Texas has had more players drafted to play professional football than any other team in the Sun Belt Conference. Since the first NFL draft in 1936, North Texas has had 77 players drafted, including seven players picked in the first round. Joe Greene is the highest drafted player ever from North Texas when he was selected by the Pittsburgh Steelers with the fourth overall pick in 1969.

Not since Scott Hall started the first game in 2001 and 2002 has the Mean Green had the same quarterback start the first game in back-to-back seasons. Derek Thompson became the first QB since Hall to do that when he took the opening snap vs. LSU Saturday.

### Thompson Inches Toward Top-10

Junior quarterback Derek Thompson is closing in on joining the list of top-10 all-time passing leaders in North Texas history. Thompson will go into this week's game 803 yards shy of the top 10 with 2,045 career passing yards. He already ranks fifth all-time in passing efficiency entering the 2012 season, with a rating of 121.63. His career completion percentage of 58.4 also ranks fourth-best in school history.

### A Three Headed Monster

Replacing the all-time leading rusher in school history, Lance Dunbar, will not fall on just one man this year. Brandin Byrd, Jeremy Brown, and Antoine Jimmerson all saw action against LSU last week and all are expected to get a lot of action this season. Between the three, they only have a combined total of 279 rushing yards for their career. Byrd has 256 of those yards in his first two seasons. Brown, a former walk-on until who was put on scholarship this year, has 23 career rushing yards, while Jimmerson is a redshirt freshman played his first-ever game for North Texas against LSU.

### Youthful Veterans

The Mean Green offensive line still features a youthful look despite having a veteran feel. Starters Antonio Johnson, Cyril Lemon and Mason Y'Barbo are just sophomores, but the trio started a combined 35 games last year. Lemon and Y'Barbo started all 12 games while Johnson started the final 11. Aaron Fortenberry, the lone senior, has started 22 consecutive games on the offensive line. Between the four players, they have started 60 combined career games.

### Walk-On to Starter

Senior wide receiver Ivan Delgado was just a practice player at the beginning of last season. By the end of the year, he was the fourth-leading receiver for the Mean Green. The former walk-on is a converted high school quarterback who came up with 26 catches for 305 yards and two touchdowns last season. Delgado started four of the last five games and this year's season-opener at LSU.

### Making Plenty of Lemonade

Sophomore offensive guard Cyril Lemon had one of the most remarkable freshmen campaigns in North Texas history. Lemon started all 12 games and was the only true freshman in the Sun Belt Conference to be named all-conference in 2011 and just the second freshman offensive lineman in Sun Belt history to earn all-conference honors. He was the only true freshman offensive lineman in the nation to start all 12 games and receive all-conference honors. He is the first North Texas freshman offensive lineman to be named all-conference since 2000.

### Sack Attack Is Back

The North Texas defense had 27 sacks in 2011, which was the most in a single season since 2002 and more than double the total the Mean Green had just two seasons ago. North Texas had not registered more than 20 sacks in a season since 2004, but the 27 sacks last year were the most since the Mean Green had 43 in 2002. Prior to 2011, North Texas had only 91 total sacks in the last six seasons combined - an average just over 15 a year.

### Linebacker Legacy

Junior linebacker Zach Orr is the leader for the Mean Green defense and the latest in a long line of great linebackers at North Texas. Orr was third on the team in tackles as a freshman and led the team in tackles as a sophomore in 2011 despite missing the final three games of the season due to an injury. It was the first time since Aaron Weathers in 2005 that a sophomore led North Texas in tackles. Orr was a second-team all-conference selection last season, making him the 16th linebacker from North Texas to earn all-conference honors since 2001. There have been six first-team all-conference linebackers from North Texas since 2001 and three of those honorees went on to the NFL. Brad Kassell and Cody Spencer were both three-time all-conference players and spent seven and six years in the NFL respectively in the early 2000's. Craig Robertson is in his second year in the NFL after earning all-conference accolades at North Texas from 2008-10.

### Sarge Reporting For Duty

Junior defensive end Brandon McCoy is one of the few veterans on the North Texas defense, but after just two years he is inching his way into the record books. McCoy, has 11.5 tackles for a loss and 7.0 sacks for his career, which is the most of any returning lineman for North Texas. He needs only 5.5 tackles for a loss and five sacks to enter the top-10 all-time in both categories at North Texas. McCoy was a walk-on to the North Texas team in 2010 after serving in the Army from 2004-2008. McCoy was deployed to Iraq on September 11, 2006 and returned October 11, 2007 after serving 13 months overseas.

### A Second Look

The only unit on the North Texas depth chart that took a significant hit from last season was the defensive secondary. The Mean Green lost all four starters in the backfield from last year and has four new faces starting this season. This is the first time that North Texas has started four new players in the secondary since the return to FBS football in 1995. Of the eight total starters that North Texas is replacing from last season, four of them come from the defensive secondary.

### Punt Returns Lacking

The last four years, North Texas has struggled finding a consistent punt returner. Since 2008, North Texas has averaged less than six yards a return and over that four-year stretch averaged just 4.4 yards a return. Last season North Texas had the most punt return yards since 2007, but failed to reach the 100-yard mark. North Texas has not returned a punt for a TD since 2007, which covers a span of 40 games. The last three punt returns for TD's have come off of blocked punts. The last true punt return for a TD for the Mean Green came in 2004 when Johnny Quinn brought back a punt 85 yards for a TD against ULM, 88 games ago.

Dan McCarney knows how to build football programs. He was a part of historical turnarounds at Iowa and Wisconsin. He was the architect of his own turnaround at Iowa State. He helped win a national championship at Florida. He knows what it takes to bring a program back from obscurity and he knows how to make successful programs flourish.

McCarney didn't become a successful coach by chance. He has coached for, with and against some of the most highly-respected coaches in the history of the game. He developed his skills under College Football Hall of Fame head coach Hayden Fry at Iowa. He honed his skills under another Hall of Famer in Barry Alvarez at Wisconsin. Most recently, he was a top assistant under current Ohio State head coach Urban Meyer at Florida. He simply knows what it takes to win.

McCarney, 59, took over a program that had not won more than three games in any of the last seven years when he was named the Mean Green's 18th head football coach November, 30, 2010. In his first year, he helped North Texas win five games and finish higher in the final Sun Belt Conference standings than it had in any year since 2004. McCarney also helped North Texas set a single-season attendance record with an average of 18,864 people at each home game.

With more than 30 years of college coaching experience, including 13 years as a head coach at Iowa State University, McCarney is an established leader. He came to North Texas after serving as the assistant head coach at the University of Florida where he had been since 2008.

McCarney began his coaching career at the University of Iowa, where he was an assistant under Fry for 11 years. He continued his career as the defensive coordinator at the University of Wisconsin under Alvarez, directing some of the best defensive teams in that schools history. In his 11 years with Fry at Iowa, their teams went to eight bowl games after not having a winning season the previous 19 years. At Wisconsin, McCarney helped turn a team that had won 10 games in five years into a Big 10 Conference championship and Rose Bowl appearance in his fourth year.

McCarney took over as head coach at Iowa State in 1995, assuming responsibility of a program that had enjoyed just three winning seasons in the 16 years prior to his arrival.

The year before McCarney became head coach at Iowa State, the Cyclones suffered through an 0-10-1 record. His rebuilding process at Iowa State took five years, but in his sixth season, he became the first head coach in the previous 94 years at Iowa State to win nine games in a season and gave the Cyclones their first-ever bowl victory and first bowl appearance in 23 years.

McCarney led Iowa State to five bowl games from 2000-05 and was named the Big 12 Conference Coach of the Year in 2004 when his team earned a Big 12 North co-championship. In 119 years of football at Iowa State, only 17 teams have won seven or more games in a season and McCarney coached five of those. McCarney remains the longest-tenured (141 games) and winningest (56 victories) head football coach in Iowa State history. His overall record in 13 years as the Cyclones head coach is 61-92.

After leaving Iowa State, McCarney spent one season as the assistant head coach at the University of South Florida, where his defensive line ranked third in the nation in tackles for loss. From 2008-10 at the University of Florida, McCarney helped guide the team to two Southeastern Conference Championship games and three bowl appearances. His 2008 Florida team finished with a 13-1 record and won the BCS National Championship behind a defense that ranked fourth in the nation in scoring defense and ninth nationally in total defense.

In all, McCarney has been part of 19 bowl games in 35 years as a collegiate coach, five of which are current BCS bowls. He has coached 22 players that have been drafted by the NFL, including nine that have gone in the first three rounds.

McCarney is a 1975 graduate of the University of Iowa where he was a three-year letterman on the offensive line and a team captain in 1974. He is married to his wife Margy and has three children, Jillian, Melanie and Shane.

LSU was looking for the kind of massacre oddsmakers expected, but North Texas was having none of that. What each had to settle for was a 41-14 LSU victory in both team's season opener. LSU ended any Mean Green hopes of a win by exploding for a 24-0 lead in the first half, but North Texas shook off the effects of the haymaker to score twice while bringing the Tiger onslaught under control.

Two Derek Thompson to Brelan Chancellor touchdown passes gave North Texas 14 points - more than the Mean Green had scored in four previous meetings with LSU. LSU's 41 points matched the fewest the Tigers have scored against North Texas, and the 27-point margin was the closest in the series.

North Texas did not allow a sack to the much-touted LSU pass rush, and Chancellor had 114 yards receiving.
