MEAN GREEN BEGINS 2012 SEASON AT TOP-RANKED LSU

→ North Texas opens the 2012 season at No. 1 ranked LSU. It's the second season for head coach Dan McCarney, who last year led the Mean Green to its most wins since 2004. LSU is coming off a 13-1 season in which it lost to Alabama 21-0 in the BCS National championship game. The Tigers are No. 1 in the coaches poll and No. 3 in the AP poll.

→ Dan McCarney has never faced LSU as a head coach, but he was 2-1 against the Tigers as the defensive coordinator at Florida from 2008-10.

→ The Mean Green returns nine starters on offense and five on defense. Junior quarterback Derek Thompson threw for 1,759 yards last season, which was the fifth-most passing yards in a single season since 1995. On defense, leading tackler Zach Orr returns after leading the Mean Green with 74 tackles last season despite missing the final three games with an injury.

→ The Mean Green opens the season on the road for the 11th straight year. It is the third time in school history that North Texas has started a year out against the No. 1 team in the nation.

→ North Texas is 37-56-3 all-time in the season debut. The Mean Green has won just two season-openers in the last 15 years, a 14-7 win at Middle Tennessee in 2005 and a 20-10 victory at Ball State in 2009.

→ In the first-year under head coach Dan McCarney North Texas averaged only 41.4 yards a game in penalties, which was the fewest penalty yards per game for a Mean Green team since

→ Turnover margin was another area of dramatic turnaround last season for the Mean Green. North Texas went from 71st in the nation in 2010 at -3 to 15th in the nation at +9 in turnover margin in 2011. The turnaround was the 12th-best in the nation last season. From 2006-2010, the Mean Green was a combined -60 in turnover margin. Last year was the first time North Texas had been on the positive side in the turnover margin since 2004.

- **106** The combined yards returning in the backfield for North Texas running backs from 2011. Junior Brandin Byrd had 83 yards, senior Jeremy Brown 23 yards and Antoinne Jimmerson was a redshirt.
- **113** The leading rusher returning for North Texas is quarterback Derek Thompson, who ran for 113 yards last season.

THE LAST TIME VERSUS LSU..... BATON ROUGE, La. (9/14/08) - The defending national champion Louisiana State Tigers proved too quick for the North Texas football team in a 41-3 win over the Mean Green on Saturday night. The North Texas offense played crisp and efficient against the defending SEC champions, but big plays from the Tigers broke the back of the Mean Green. LSU posted eight plays of 20 yards or greater which ignited the crowd of 91,602, the largest to ever see a North Texas team play. The NT offensive line gave Giovanni Vizza ample time to complete 22-of-40 attempts for 149 yards, including 16-of-26 for 110 yards in the first half. Royce Hill set up the Mean Green offense with its best field position of the day when he intercepted an Andrew Hatch pass and returned it to the LSU 25-yard line. Jeremy Knott got the Mean Green on the scoreboard five plays later with a 33-yard field goal to bring North Texas back to within a touchdown, at 10-3, just inside the second quarter.

The 97th Season Set to Begin

North Texas will begin its 97th season of football when it kicks off the 2012 season at LSU on Sept. 1. Since the inaugural season in 1913, North Texas has accumulated a record of 475-458-33, amassed 25 conference championships and played in seven bowl games.

Facing No. 1

LSU will be the fourth top-ranked team that North Texas has played in school history. North Texas last played a No. 1 team when it began the year at Oklahoma in 2003. The other two times North Texas played the top-ranked team in the nation was 1987 at Oklahoma and 1965 at Arkansas.

Vs. Ranked Opponents

The matchup with No. 1 LSU will be the 12th time in 13 years that North Texas has played a team ranked in the top 10 in the nation. Since the 2000 season, the Mean Green has faced a top-10 opponent every year except 2010. Of those 12 opponents, eight were ranked in the top five. North Texas has never beaten a top 10 opponent and hasn't beaten a ranked opponent since a 14-9 win over No. 20 San Diego State in 1974.

Returning Rushing Yards

With the departure of the school's all-time leading rusher Lance Dunbar, North Texas will have to rely on a bevy of inexperienced backs to fill his shoes. The Mean Green returns only 338 rushing yards from last year – and only 106 of that is from the running back position (Byrd with 83 and Brown with23). Only five schools in FBS football return fewer total rushing yards than North Texas going into 2012.

Seniors Wanted

North Texas enters the 2012 campaign with youth spread across the entire lineup, but no place reflects that more than the secondary. The Mean Green is one of only four teams in the nation without a senior starter in the secondary to begin the year. Ironically, LSU is one of the other three teams in the nation with a senior starter in the secondary, along with Florida State and Virgina.

Atterberry Named to Ray Guy Watch List

North Texas senior punter Will Atterberry is on the Ray Guy Award preseason watch list heading into the 2012 season. Atterberry, who is one of 25 players on the list, was also a nominee last season for the Ray Guy Award, which goes to the nation's best punter. Atterberry led the Sun Belt Conference in punting last season at 43.5 yards a kick and was named to the All-Sun Belt First Team. Atterberry had 16 punts of over 50 yards in 2011 and 26 punts that were inside the 20-yard line, which ranked eighth nationally. His average of 43.5 yards a kick was 24th in the nation last season and he is the nation's 16th-leading punter returning for the 2012 season. North Texas was ninth in the nation last season in net punting average at 39.8 yards. Atterberry has led North Texas in punting in three straight years and his average of 43.5 yards a punt in 2011 ranked fifth all-time at North Texas. Atterberry is the only punter from the Sun Belt Conference to make this list.

Two Named to Preseason All-Conference

North Texas senior punter Will Atterberry and sophomore offensive lineman Cyril Lemon were named to the 2012 Preseason All-Sun Belt team. Atterberry was the leading punter in the Sun Belt Conference last season, while Lemon was the only true freshman offensive lineman in the nation to start all 12 games and receive all-conference honors. Lemon is one of only three sophomores to be part of the preseason all-conference team and is the only underclassman on the all-conference team that is an offensive lineman.

All-Purpose Man

Wide Receiver Brelan Chancellor racked up a career-high 1,628 all-purpose yards in 2011, which was the fifth most in school history. He set the single-game record for all-purpose yards against Houston with 332. Chancellor had a school-record 1,094 kickoff return yards, 457 receiving yards, 46 rushing yards, and 31 yards returning punts. For his career, Chancellor will be chasing former teammate Lance Dunbar who holds the all-purpose yard career mark at 5,375. Chancellor sits with 2,573 all-purpose yards through his first two seasons. In fact, Chancellor was so versatile in 2011, he is the only player to have more than 30 yards in rushing, receiving, punt returns, and kickoff returns in a single season since Ja'Mel Branch in 2002. He enters the 2012 season needing 425 yards to break into the top-10 all-time at North Texas in all-purpose yards.

First Year Success

Head Coach Dan McCarney started to turn the North Texas program around in short time. In his first year, McCarney led North Texas to its most wins in a single season since 2004 and a tie for the fourth-most wins in a single season since returning to FBS football in 1995. The Mean Green also notched the most league wins since 2004 and McCarney had the most conference wins by a first-year head coach at the FBS level at North Texas since 1973. McCarney collected the most wins by a first-year head coach since 1994 and the sixth-most by a first-year head coach ever at North Texas. The five wins also matched the most wins by a first-year head coach at the FBS level since 1979.

Television Networks Go Green

The Mean Green will have its first seven games televised. The season opener at LSU is on ESPNU. The home opener against Texas Southern will be broadcast on TXA 21 in Dallas/Fort Worth. The matchup against Kansas State is going to be televised on Fox Sports. The first two Sun Belt Conference games -- at home against Troy and a road matchup with Florida Atlantic -- will be televised on ESPN3. On Oct. 6, Comcast Sports South will broadcast North Texas and Houston before ESPN2 spotlights North Texas at home against Louisiana-Lafayette for a Tuesday night feature. The final home game of the year against South Alabama will be on TXA 21 once again. The Mean Green's final televised regular season game will be on the road at Western Kentucky on Nov. 24, broadcast on the Sun Belt Network.

Momentum Moving Forward

For only the fifth time since 1986, North Texas ended the season having won three of its final five games. The last five games were the best since 2004 for the Mean Green. The 59-7 win over Middle Tennessee to end the 2011 season was the biggest margin of victory for the Mean Green ever in Sun Belt conference play while racking up 464 rushing yards, which tied a school record. The 59 points were the most points in a season-finale game for North Texas since scoring 63 against Drake in 1976.

Stormy Series

There is something about the series with North Texas and LSU and the threat of hurricanes. With Hurricane Issac taking aim on the Louisiana gulf coast this week, it is just the latest in what has been a stormy series between the Mean Green and the Tigers. In 2005, North Texas was scheduled to open the season at LSU on Sept. 3 but Hurricane Katrina hit Louisiana causing the game to be re-scheduled for later in the year. The next meeting between the two teams came in 2008 on the heels of Hurricane Gustav which hit Louisiana 12 days before the game and in the middle of Hurricane Ike which made landfall along the Texas/Louisiana border on the day of the game. Louisiana is not the only place North Texas seems to draw storms to, as the 2005 game at FAU had to be moved to Miami's Pro Player Stadium because of damage along the Florida coast from Hurricane Wilma two weeks earlier.

Graduate Work

Quarterback Derek Thompson and defensive lineman Ryan Boutwell each completed their undergraduate degrees by graduating in August. Both Thompson and Boutwell earned their degrees in Kinesiology in three years and have two years of eligibility remaining. Boutwell begins graduate school this fall in Kinesiology while Thompson begins graduate school in recreation and Leisure Studies.

See You In C-USA

On May 4, 2012 the University of North Texas was extended and accepted an invitation for Conference USA membership effective July 1, 2013. North Texas is one of six schools that will be joining Conference USA. North Texas, the University of Texas-San Antonio, Louisiana Tech University, Florida International University and the University of North Carolina-Charlotte accepted invitations on May 4. On May 17, Old Dominion University announced it was also accepting C-USA's invitation. Each new member will join the league in all sports for 2013; Charlotte will begin conference participation in football in 2015. The metro area population of these schools is nearly 18 million. Existing members are East

Carolina University, Marshall University, Rice University, University of Southern Mississippi, Tulane University, The University of Tulsa, University of Alabama at Birmingham (UAB) and University of Texas El Paso (UTEP). Divisions will be set in the near future. The 14 members will also allow the Conference to continue to host its annual Football Championship game pitting champions from the East and West Divisions.

Final Season In the Sun

North Texas football begins its 12th and final season as a member of the Sun Belt Conference before joining Conference USA in time for the 2013 season. The Mean Green entered the Sun Belt Conference in 2001, finished the campaign as Sun Belt Co-Champions and earned a berth in the New Orleans Bowl. North Texas went on to win four straight Sun Belt Conference titles from 2001-04 and play in four New Orleans Bowls during the same time. North Texas had a 26-game conference winning streak that stretched from 2001-05, a record that still stands. Since 2001, the Mean Green has had 95 players named to the all-conference team, and of those 49 were first-team all-conference selections. Jamario Thomas was the 2004 SBC Player of the Year and Brandon Kennedy a two-time Player of the Year in 2003 and 2002. Thomas was the Offensive Player of the Year in 2004, while Patrick Cobbs won the award in 2003. Chris Hurd was the Defensive Player of the Year in 2003, Kennedy in 2002, and Brad Kassell in 2001. Giovanni Vizza won the Freshman of the Year in 2007, Thomas in 2004, and Ja'Mel Branch in 2001. Aaron Weathers was the Newcomer of the Year in 2005, Dylan Lineberry in 2004, and Kevin Galbreath in 2001. Coach Darrell Dickey was a four-time Coach of the Year winner from 2001-04.

Hayden Fry Tree

Former North Texas and Iowa head coach Hayden Fry has one of the most established coaching trees in the history of college football, including current Mean Green head coach Dan McCarney. Fry has had 26 of his former assistants go on to become either college or professional head coaches, including 10 that have been head coaches at the FBS (Div. I-A) level and six that are still active FBS coaches. And these are not just any coaches. The 10 FBS coaches who are former Fry assistants have combined to lead their teams to more than 60 bowl games as head coaches.

Magic Number 21

North Texas won its seventh straight game when holding an opponent to 21 points or less with a 59-7 win over Middle Tennessee to close the 2011 season. Since the beginning of the 2010 season, the Mean Green is 7-0 when holding its opponent to 21 or less, and 0-16 when allowing more than 21 points.

Captains and Leadership Committee Named

Head Coach Dan McCarney has announced the team's 2012 captains and Leadership Committee, which will serve as the primary representatives for on-field and off-field activities. Captains elected by a team vote are senior offensive lineman Aaron Fortenberry, junior quarterback Derek Thompson, junior linebacker Zach Orr and junior defensive end Brandon McCoy. The Leadership Committee for this year will be Fortenberry and Orr as well as senior Nicolas Summerfield, junior Brandin Byrd, sophomores Andrew McNulty, Mason Y'Barbo and freshmen Zac Whitfield, Antoinne Jimmerson, Kaydon Kirby and David Busby.

Quality Losses

All seven of North Texas' losses in 2011 were to teams that were bowl eligible with at least seven wins. The combined record of the three non-conference opponents to bean North Texas was 33-7, including BCS National Champion Alabama (12-1) and 14th-ranked Houston (13-1). North Texas also dropped games to Tulsa (8-5), Arkansas State (10-3), Louisiana-Lafayette (9-4), FIU (8-5) and Western Kentucky (7-5).

New Faces, Old Friends

Head coach Dan McCarney added two new coaches to his staff this past season, Jon Skladany as his defensive coordinator and Noah Joseph as the safeties coach. Skladany and McCarney have a long history together having worked together at Iowa State. Skladany was the defensive coordinator for the Cyclones from 1997-06 with McCarney. Most recently he was the defensive coordinator at UCF, where last season the Golden Knights finished ninth in the nation in total defense. Joseph arrives at North Texas from Montana State where he was the Co-Defensive Coordinator and secondary coach since 2007.

Preseason Picks

In its final season in the Sun Belt Conference, the Mean Green has been picked to finish eighth in the preseason poll of the league's coaches. FIU was chosen as the favorite while defending conference champion Arkansas State was picked second.

Mean Green Bloodlines

North Texas has its share of players on the roster that have great genes of their own but some have even better bloodlines. Linebacker Zachary Orr is the son of former NFL tight end Terry Orr, who was a member of the Washington Redskins Super Bowl teams in 1987 and 1991. Senior wide receiver Chris Bynes is the brother of Josh Bynes who was the leading tackler for the 2011 national champion Auburn Tigers and current member of the Baltimore Ravens. Junior linebacker Jeremy Phillips is the younger brother of Jason Phillips, the 2008 Mountain West Defensive Player of the Year for TCU and current Carolina Panthers linebacker. Tight end Andrew Power's brother, James, is the deep snapper for Thundering Herd of Marshall.

Well Represented in the NFL

North Texas has had more players drafted to play professional football than any other team in the Sun Belt Conference. Since the first NFL draft in 1936, North Texas has had 77 players drafted, including seven players picked in the first round. Joe Greene is the highest drafted player ever from North Texas when he was selected by the Pittsburgh Steelers with the fourth overall pick in 1969.

The Merry-Go-Round Stops

Since the start of the 2002 season, North Texas has had eight different quarterbacks starting the first game of the season in the last 10 years. Not since Scott Hall started the first game in 2001 and 2002 has the Mean Green had the same quarterback start the first game in back-to-back seasons. Derek Thompson will be the first QB since Hall to do that when he takes the opening snap vs. LSU Saturday.

Thompson Inches Toward Top-10

Quarterback Derek Thompson begins the 2012 campaign 946 passing yards away from joining the top-10 all-time passers at North Texas. He has 1,902 career yards, but passing yards isn't the only category Thompson is approaching. He already ranks fifth all-time in passing efficiency entering the 2012 season, with a rating of 121.63. For his career, his passing percentage is 58.4, ranks fourth-best in school history.

A Three Headed Monster

Replacing the all-time leading rusher in school history, Lance Dunbar, will not fall on just one man this year. Brandin Byrd, Jeremy Brown, and Antoinne Jimmerson are all expected to get time at the running back spot. Between the three, they only have a combined total of 279 rushing yards for their career. Byrd has 256 of those yards in his first two seasons. Brown, a former walk-on until who was put on scholarship this year, has 23 career rushing yards, while Jimmerson is a redshirt freshman who has yet to play at game at the FBS level.

Young But Veterans

The Mean Green offensive line still features a youthful look despite having a veteran fell. Antonio Johnson, Cyril Lemon and Mason Y'Barbo are just sophomores, but the trio started 35 games last year. Lemon and Y'Barbo started all 12 games while Johnson started the final 11 games. Aaron Fortenberry, the lone senior, has started 21 consecutive games on the offensive line and between the four players, they have started 56 combined career games.

Walk-On To Starter

Senior wide receiver Ivan Delgado was just a practice player at the beginning of last season. By the end of the year, he was the fourth leading receiver for the Mean Green. The former walk-on, a converted high school quarterback, came up with 26 catches for 305 yards and two touchdowns last season. Delgado started four of the last five games and had at least one catch in seven straight games. His breakout performance came in the victory over Troy, where he finished with nine receptions for 89 yards and a touchdown.

Topping 4,000 yards

For a school record fifth straight season the North Texas offense topped the 4,000 total yard mark in 2011. The Mean Green finished with a 4,101 total yards of offense, which was the 11th best total in school history. North Texas finished with the 2011 season with a bang, averaging 437.3 yards in the final three games, which included tying the school record with 464 rushing yards in the final game of the year against MTSU.

Making Plenty Of Lemonade

Cyril Lemon turned in one of the best freshman season playing the offensive line last season for the Mean Green. Lemon, who started all 12 games, was the only true freshman in the Sun Belt Conference to be on one of the three all-conference teams. Lemon was the only true freshman offensive lineman in the nation to start all 12 games and receive all-conference honors. He is the first freshman offensive lineman to earn all-conference honors at North Texas since 2000. Lemon was just the second freshman offensive lineman to earn all-conference honors in Sun Belt history.

Sack Attack Is Back

The North Texas defense had 27 sacks last season, which was the most in a single season since 2002 and more than double the total the Mean Green had just two seasons ago. North Texas had not registered more than 20 sacks in a season since 2004, but the 27 sacks last year were the most since the Mean Green had 43 in 2002. Prior to 2011, North Texas had only 91 total sacks in the last six seasons, an average just over 15 a year. Twelve different players had sacks last season for North Texas.

No Sophomore Jinx

Linebacker Zach Orr added to his freshman season of 60 tackles with 74 last season in 2011 despite missing the final three games of the season due to an injury. Orr led the Mean Green in tackles, which was the first time since Aaron Weathers and the 2005 season that a sophomore has led North Texas in tackles.

No More Waiting

Safety Marcus Trice is set to see his first action in two seasons after sitting out last year after transferring from Oklahoma. Trice played in all 13 games as a freshman at OU in 2009 and in all 14 games as a sophomore in 2010 with the Sooners. In all he played in 27 games with Oklahoma, primarily on special teams. Coming out of high school in Mesquite, Texas, Trice was ranked as the 174th best player in the nation according to Rivals.com

Sarge Reporting For Duty

Junior lineman Brandon McCoy is one of the few veterans on the North Texas defense, but after just two years he is inching his way into the record books. McCoy, has 11.5 tackles for a loss and 7.0 sacks for his career, which is the most of any returning lineman for North Texas. He needs only 5.5 tackles for a loss and five sacks to enter the top-10 all-time in both categories at North Texas. McCoy was a walk-on to the North Texas team in 2010 after serving his country in the Army from 2004-2008. McCoy was deployed to Iraq on September 11, 2006 and returned October 11, 2007 after serving 13 months overseas.

A Second Look

The only area of the North Texas depth chart that took a significant hit from last season was the secondary. The Mean Green lost all four starters from last year and will have four new faces to start the season. That is the first time that North Texas will start four new players in the secondary since the return to Division I football in 1995. Of the eight starters that North Texas is replacing from last season, four of them come from the secondary.

Punt Returns Lacking

The last four years, North Texas has struggled finding a consistent punt returner. Since 2008, North Texas has averaged less than six yards a return and over that four-year stretch averaged just 4.4 yards a return. Last season North Texas had the most punt return yards since 2007, but failed to reach the 100-yard mark. North Texas has not returned a punt for a TD since 2007, which covers a span of 39 games. The last three punt returns for TD's have come off of blocked punts. The last true punt return for a TD for the Mean Green came in 2004 when Johnny Quinn brought back a punt 85 yards for a TD against ULM, 87 games ago.

Home Defense System

North Texas allowed an average of 21 points per game at Apogee Stadium last season, the fewest points allowed per game since 2003. The last time the Mean Green allowed an average of 21 points-per-game over a season was in 1999. Ironically, North Texas featured a scoring defense of under 16.4 points-per-game the following four seasons.



Dan McCarney knows how to build football programs. He was a part of historical turnarounds at Iowa and Wisconsin. He was the architect of his own turnaround at Iowa State. He helped win a national championship at Florida. He knows what it takes to bring a program back from obscurity and he knows how to make successful programs flourish.

McCarney didn't become a successful coach by chance. He has coached for, with and against some of the most highly-respected coaches in the history of the game. He developed his skills under College Football Hall of Fame head coach Hayden Fry at Iowa. He honed his skills under another Hall of Famer in Barry Alvarez at Wisconsin. Most recently, he was a top assistant under current Ohio State head coach Urban Meyer at Florida. He simply knows what it takes to win.

McCarney, 59, took over a program that had not won more than three games in any of the last seven years when he was named the Mean Green's 18th head football coach November, 30, 2010. In his first year, he helped North Texas win five games and finish higher in the final Sun Belt Conference standings than it had in any year since 2004. McCarney also helped North Texas set a single-season attendance record with an average of 18,864 people at each home game.

With more than 30 years of college coaching experience, including 13 years as a head coach at Iowa State University, McCarney is an established leader. He came to North Texas after serving as the assistant head coach at the University of Florida where he had been since 2008.

McCarney began his coaching career at the University of Iowa, where he was an assistant under Fry for 11 years. He continued his career as the defensive coordinator at the University of Wisconsin under Alvarez, directing some



of the best defensive teams in that schools history. In his 11 years with Fry at Iowa, their teams went to eight bowl games after not having a winning season the previous 19 years. At Wisconsin, McCarney helped turn a team that had won 10 games in five years into a Big 10 Conference championship and Rose Bowl appearance in his fourth year.

McCarney took over as head coach at Iowa State in 1995, assuming responsibility of a program that had enjoyed just three winning seasons in the 16 years prior to his arrival.

The year before McCarney became head coach at Iowa State, the Cyclones suffered through an 0-10-1 record. His rebuilding process at Iowa State took five years, but in his sixth season, he became the first head coach in the previous 94 years at Iowa State to win nine games in a season and gave the Cyclones their first-ever bowl victory and first bowl appearance in 23 years.

McCarney led Iowa State to five bowl games from 2000-05 and was named the Big 12 Conference Coach of the Year in 2004 when his team earned a Big 12 North co-championship. In 119 years of football at Iowa State, only 17 teams have won seven or more games in a season and McCarney coached five of those. McCarney remains the longest-tenured (141 games) and winningest (56 victories) head football coach in Iowa State history. His overall record in 13 years as the Cyclones head coach is 61-92.

After leaving Iowa State, McCarney spent one season as the assistant head coach at the University of South Florida, where his defensive line ranked third in the nation in tackles for loss. From 2008-10 at the University of Florida, McCarney helped guide the team to two Southeastern Conference Championship games and three bowl appearances. His 2008 Florida team finished with a 13-1 record and won the BCS National Championship behind a defense that ranked fourth in the nation in scoring defense and ninth nationally in total defense.

In all, McCarney has coached in 20 bowl games in 35 years as a collegiate coach, five of which are current BCS bowls. He has coached 22 players that have been drafted by the NFL, including nine that have gone in the first three rounds.

McCarney is a 1975 graduate of the University of Iowa where he was a three-year letterman on the offensive line and a team captain in 1974. He is married to his wife Margy and has three children, Jillian, Melanie and Shane.
